

Construction Update – 12/17/20

Contractors for Lee County are installing new sanitary sewer force main along the east side of McGregor Boulevard beginning just south of Whiskey Creek Drive. Crews will continue north on McGregor Boulevard to the north side of Whiskey Creek Drive and north on the west side of Greenbriar Drive, then east along the north side of Tanglewood Parkway/Manchester Boulevard until reaching the Tanglewood Elementary School.

We wanted to make you aware of the following upcoming work that will involve lane closures and detours.

Greenbriar Drive closed between Tanglewood Parkway and Brentwood Parkway

Beginning Monday, December 21 through Wednesday, December 23, crews are expected to close Greenbriar Drive to through traffic while crews install sanitary sewer force main. Through motorists should follow detour signs. Access to Greenbriar Drive will be maintained for residents and emergency vehicles from Brentwood Parkway.

Tanglewood Parkway westbound closed between McGregor Boulevard and Fairfield Drive

Beginning Monday, December 21 through Wednesday December 23, crews are expected to close the westbound lane of Tanglewood Pkwy between McGregor Boulevard and Fairfield Drive while crews install sanitary sewer force main. Access from McGregor Boulevard onto Tanglewood Parkway eastbound will remain open. Tanglewood Parkway westbound motorists will be directed to the following detours:

- North on Fairfield Drive then west on Brentwood Parkway.
- South on Fairfield Drive then west on Whiskey Creek Drive.

Whiskey Creek Drive westbound closed between McGregor Boulevard and Fairfield Drive

Beginning Monday, January 4 through Friday, January 8, crews are expected to close the westbound lane of Whiskey Creek Drive between McGregor Boulevard and Fairfield Drive while crews install sanitary sewer force main. Access from McGregor Boulevard onto Whiskey Creek Drive eastbound will remain open. Whiskey Creek Drive westbound motorists will be detoured north on Fairfield Drive then west on Tanglewood Parkway.

Residents may need to access your property from a different direction and may experience short-term delays as crews perform the work accordingly. This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions.
